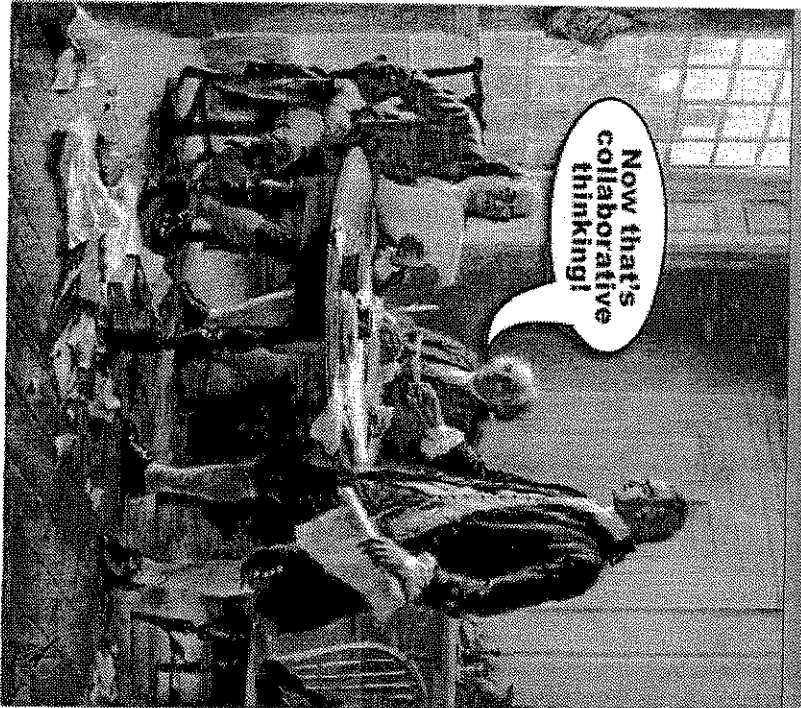

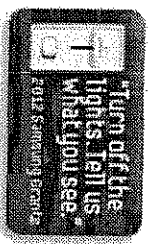
Judging: Papers will be judged by an independent panel:
